



Announcement of Pa Daet Police Station

Subject: Intention to not accept any kind of gifts from performing duties
(No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year 2026

Pa Daet Police Station is determined to enhancing operational transparency, prioritizing public interest over private benefit, and ensuring the absence of conflict of interest. This policy is consistent with the public sector development policy and aims to achieve the objectives outlined in the master plan for the national strategy issue (๒๑) ; Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (๒๐๒๓-๒๐๓๓) (revised edition). The goal is to ensure that all agencies work transparently and without conflicts of interest, thus all government officials shall strictly refrain from accepting any kind of gifts and gratuities from performing duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, we, in order to fulfill this intent and uphold the ethical standards of state officials, the Superintendent Pa Daet Police Station and all police officers to not accept any kind of gifts or gratuities from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy), whether before, during, or all after the performance of duties as well as strictly adherence to the notification of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Provisions of the Acceptance of property or any other Benefits on Ethical basis by State Officials B.E.๒๕๖๓ (๒๐๒๐). This commitment aims to collectively foster and organizational culture and values of integrity in the performance of our duties, while rejecting patronage systems. We shall avoid any actions that may influence discretionary judgment or decision – making in the discharge of our responsibilities, which could lead to discrimination or unfair practices. Furthermore, we are dedicated to preventing conflicts of interest and strengthening public trust by performing our duties with good governance.
